SPEED Lab Vehicle Use Request Process for Faculty/Staff

To request use of the SPEED Lab vehicle, faculty and staff must adhere to UNLV's Vehicle Use and Safety Program, including rules for sidewalk access. Follow the steps below to ensure compliance and obtain necessary permissions.

- Review Vehicle Use and Safety Requirements

- Submit a SPEED Lab Use Request Form

- Comply with Sidewalk Access Rules During Use
 - When operating the SPEED Lab vehicle on sidewalks or pedestrian walkways, follow these specific rules:
 - Speed Limit: Do not exceed 3 MPH at any time.
 - Pedestrian Right of Way: Yield to all pedestrians; do not pass pedestrians.
 - Class Break Restrictions: Avoid using sidewalks during class breaks.
 - Clearance of Fire Lanes and Entrances: Ensure that fire lanes and building entrances or exits remain unobstructed at all times.
- Post-Use Reporting
 - After the scheduled use, complete a post-use report, detailing any issues, accidents, or operational concerns, and submit it to the SPEED Lab coordinator.

By following these steps, faculty and staff can ensure the safe, approved, and compliant use of the SPEED Lab vehicle on campus for research, educational, and community engagement activities.
